Re: immunizations available at Union School-Based Health Center for students in Union County

The Union School-Based Health Center in Union is offering immunizations to any school-age students in Union County, including **Cove School District** students.

The School Exclusion date of February 15, 2017, is coming up fast and if your student hasn't received the immunizations required by Oregon law (or you have not submitted a medical/non-medical exemption), your student will not be allowed to attend school starting February 15, 2017.

Immunizations are administered at the Union SBHC on:

- Tuesdays (9:30 a.m. -1:45 p.m.)
- Wednesdays (9:30 a.m.-1:45 p.m.)
- Thursdays (9:30 a.m.-11:45 a.m.).

Please make an appointment for your student by **calling the Union SBHC at 541-562-9418** so that we can make sure our quantity of vaccines meets the significant demand.

The Union School-Based Health Center is located on the campus of Union Schools next to the SE Miller Building (the elementary school for grades K-3).

Parents/guardians: please bring your insurance card or insurance information with you.

If your child is **under age 15**, you will need to fill out the short SBHC Treatment Consent in order for your child to receive immunizations here.

Students **age 15 and older** may fill out the SBHC Treatment Consent for themselves.
